

Camper Instructions

LODGING

We will use cabins for our accommodations. There is a maximum of 12 or 30 guests per cabin depending on the need and size of our group. All cabins are heated during winter months. They include shared bathrooms and sleeping areas, separate private sleeping room for chaperons or counselors. You will need to bring your own linens, towels, pillows, sleeping bags, blankets, and toiletries. The Wonderland Camp can provide towels and linens for an additional charge.

ADULT CHAPERONS AND COUNSELORS

Depending on the number of participants, retreat directors will appoint adult individuals to assist with the program activities during the duration of retreat. Since the Wonderland Camp is an independent organization and not an integral part of the Serbian Orthodox Church on this continent, unfortunately we cannot provide stipends or free lodging, food and activities for our chaperons and counselors. All participants are expected to pay the retreat participation fee of \$150.

FOOD SERVICE

During the retreat program Wonderland Camp staff will provide meals for our participants. All meals are prepared on site by professional and licensed cooks.

WINTER CLOTHING

You can bring the following: warm jacket, scarf, long sleeve shirts, snow pants, winter boots, gloves and mittens, warm sweaters, warm hats, etc.

WINTER GEAR FOR OUTSIDE ACTIVITIES

Weather permitting, we will be using a nearby hill on the camp property for downhill sledding and tubing. We **DO NOT** recommend that you bring your own skis and snowboards due to liability procedures. Additionally, (if the lake on property is frozen enough) you can bring your own skates for ice skating activity.

ITEMS NOT ALLOWED AT WONDERLAND CAMP

◆ Immodest apparel (no inappropriate wording or graphics on clothing)

No electronic media: (cell phones; computers; I-pads and I-pods; video games; etc.)

◆ Shaving cream, silly string

◆ Illegal substances (alcohol, drugs, tobacco)

◆ Dangerous implements (fireworks, weapons)

◆ Jewelry and any other valuables you'd rather not see lost.

◆ Snacks, candy, or beverages

If any items on the above list are brought and found by retreat directors, they will be taken away and may result in immediate dismissal.

OTHER ACTIVITIES

Depending on weather there will be outdoor and inside activities. Besides prayer services, we will organize teaching instruction to include religion and Serbian history and culture classes, arts and crafts, music, kolo dancing, indoor sports activities, indoor games, movie time, breakout sessions with discussion and many others.
