

Lesson Plan

Lesson #1

Grade: 1-2

Duration 30-40 min

Lesson Topic: Who is God

Learning Objective/s:

Students will learn about the essential attributes of God and how we can know Him through Scripture and prayer.

I. OPENING

Begin the class with a simple prayer to help the children focus. Example: "Dear Lord, thank You for this day and for bringing us together. Help us learn more about You. Amen."



2. INTRODUCTION

Start by asking the students:

- "Who is God?"
- "What do you know about God?"

Briefly explain:

"God is our loving Father who made everything. He loves us very much and takes care of us. We can learn about Him through the Bible and by praying to Him."



3. ATTRIBUTES OF GOD (10 MINUTES)

Attributes to Focus on:

GOD IS LOVE

Explain how God loves everyone, always. Ask them how they show love and how God shows love to us.

GOD IS EVERYWHERE:

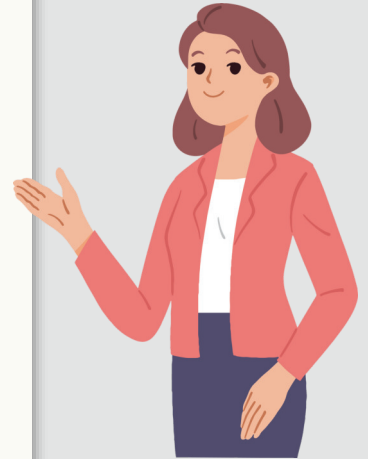
Share that God is with us wherever we go. Ask them if they've ever felt that God is close to them.

GOD IS ALL-KNOWING

Explain that God knows everything, like the number of stars in the sky or the number of hairs on our heads. Emphasize how much He cares about us.

GOD IS POWERFUL

Tell them that God made the whole world and everything in it and takes care of it daily.



4. HOW WE KNOW GOD (10 MINUTES)

SCRIPTURE:

- Explain that the Bible is God's Word. It tells us who God is and how much He loves us. Show them a Bible and share a simple Bible verse, such as: "God is love." (1 John 4:8)

PRAYER:

- Teach them that prayer is how we talk to God. He listens to us, and we can talk to Him anytime.
- Ask the children if they pray and what they like to pray about.

CLOSING REMARKS

Ask the students to share one thing they learned about God today. End the class by reminding them that God loves them, is always with them, and they can talk to Him anytime.

CLOSING PRAYER

Example: "Dear God, thank You for loving us and teaching us about You. Help us always to remember that You are with us. Amen."

Reminder

Send each child home with a small card that has the verse:

"God is love." (1 John 4:8)

Please encourage them to share it with their family and discuss what they learned in class.

Activity

ARTS AND CRAFTS ACTIVITY: "GOD IS LOVE" HEART DECORATIONS

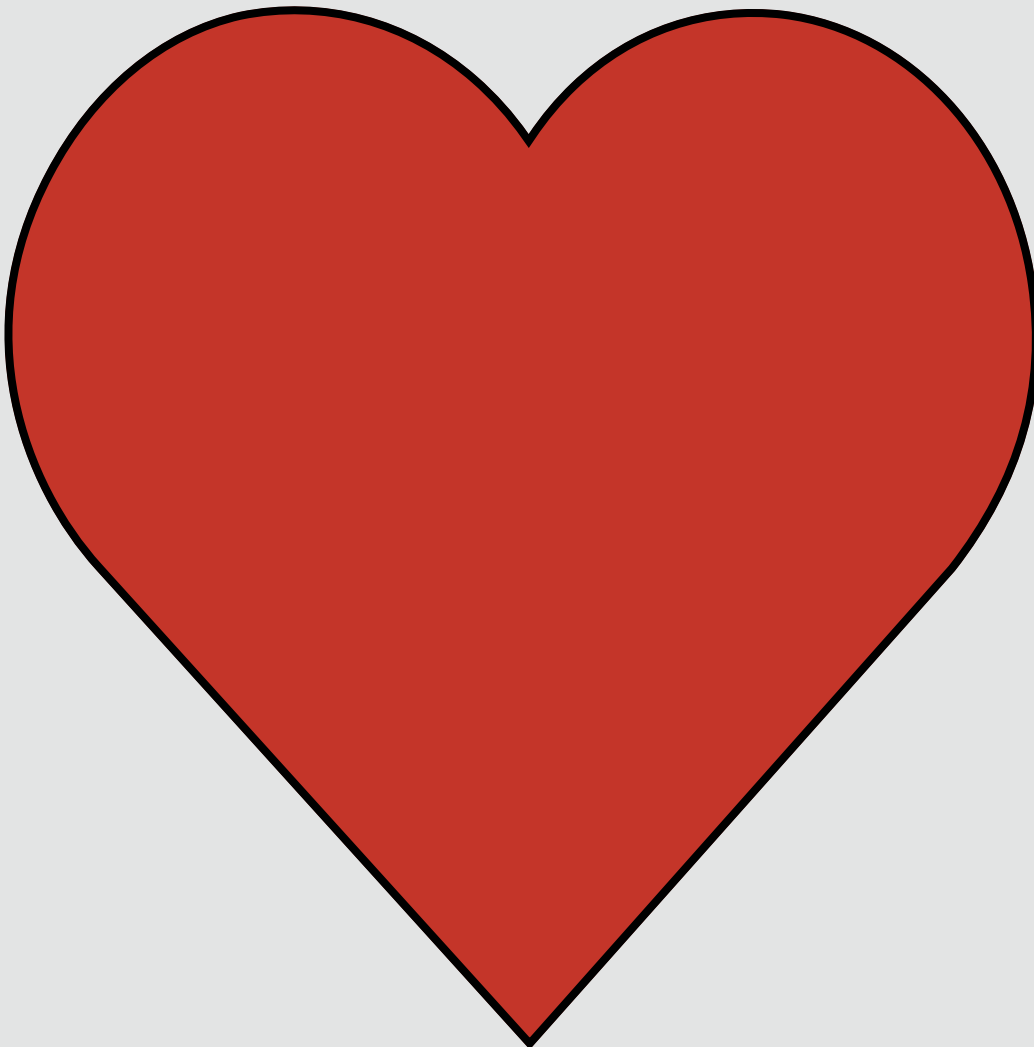
Objective: Children will create heart decorations to express God's love and learn about His attributes.

MATERIALS

Paper hearts
Crayons, Markers, Stickers

ACTIVITY

1. Give each child a paper heart.
2. Ask them to write or draw something that shows how much God loves them (for younger ones, they can draw pictures instead).
3. Decorate the heart with stickers and crayons.
4. Afterward, let each child share what they drew or wrote.

WHO IS GOD?

God is very special and loves us more than we can imagine. But who is God? Let's think about it together.

First, God is love. Have you ever hugged someone when they felt sad? Or smiled at a friend in their time of need? That's love! God's love is even greater than that. He loves every person in the entire world—no matter what. When we love others, we reflect God's love.

Second, God is everywhere. No matter where you go, He is with you. He's present at school, at home, and even when you're outside playing. You can always talk to Him because He is always nearby.

Third, God knows everything. Imagine knowing how many stars are in the sky or how many grains of sand are on the beach. God knows all of that! He even knows how many hairs are on your head. More importantly, He knows and cares about everything in your life—what makes you happy and what makes you sad.

Finally, God is powerful. He created everything—the trees, the animals, the sun, the moon, and all the stars. He cares for all He has made, including you! His power is so great that He can do anything, and He always watches over us.

So, how do we get to know God better? We can learn about God by reading the Bible. The Bible tells us many stories about God and His love for us. It's like a special letter from God to us! We can also talk to God through prayer. Just as you talk to your parents or friends, you can speak to God. He listens to everything you say and is always happy to hear from you.

REMEMBER: GOD LOVES YOU, HE IS ALWAYS WITH YOU, HE KNOWS EVERYTHING, AND HE IS VERY POWERFUL. AND YOU CAN TALK TO HIM WHENEVER YOU WANT!

God is the Creator of everything in the world. He is the One who made the sky, the stars, the earth, and all living creatures, including us.

Reading the Bible, praying, and striving to live as He taught us can deepen our understanding of God.

As we grow in faith, we learn more about His love and how we can share that love with others.
