

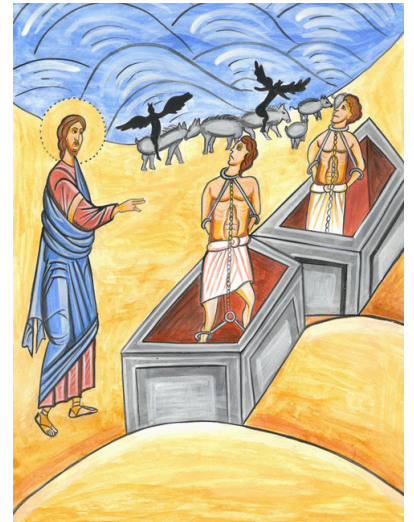

The Healing of the Two Demoniacs

Fifth Sunday After Pentecost

On the fifth Sunday after Pentecost, we hear how Jesus met two men who were suffering and tormented by demons. The people were afraid of these men, but Jesus was not. With His divine power, He freed them and restored them to peace and wholeness.



WHY IS IT IMPORTANT?

This Gospel reminds us that Jesus is stronger than every fear, trouble, and evil. No problem is too great for Him, and no person is beyond His love and mercy. Christ came to bring healing, peace, and freedom to all people.

HOW WE CAN APPLY THIS TODAY?

When we feel afraid, worried, angry, or troubled, we can turn to Jesus in prayer. We can also remember to trust in His power and seek His help whenever we face difficulties.



FOR CHILDREN

ACTION!

When you feel scared or worried this week, pray: “Lord Jesus Christ, help me and give me peace.” Draw a picture of Jesus bringing light into a dark place, and remember that He is always with you.

FOR PARENTS

Talk with your children about fears and worries they may have. Encourage them to bring these concerns to Christ in prayer and remind them that God's love is greater than anything that troubles them.
